PARKING

Unlike a lot of schools Canon Sharples benefits from having a turning circle off the busy main road which enables parents to drop and collect children safely at the start and end of the day. It also provides access to school for visitors and coaches. At the start and the end of the school day there are many times when double parking and use of the central island creates congestion. This practice also impacts on the safety of children crossing the road. Given these concerns we ask parents to use only the parking bays which are free and to exit the turning circle if none are immediately available. This will ensure the flow of traffic and safety of the road.
