

Curriculum Approach

The school predominantly uses Read Write Inc Phonics and Literacy and Language to teach English across the school. This is enhanced by a range of other resources including Grammar Hammer and Reading Plus. Opportunities for children to develop their writing skills in other areas of the curriculum are actively sought. Maths is taught following the White Rose Hub Long Term and Medium Term plan and is supplemented with Assertive Mentoring Maths. Opportunities for problem solving and reasoning are taught in all lessons. As a Church school, we teach the Liverpool Diocesan Board of Education RE syllabus which carefully maps out a range of creative plans and approaches to the teaching of RE.

The wider curriculum is taught through a range of age appropriate topics that are planned around the different curriculum areas of Science, History, Geography, Art, Design Technology, PE, Music, MFL and PSHCE.

Enrichment opportunities are always planned and include Forest School, Wider Opportunities, Let's Sing, Artist in Residences, Drama workshops, specialist PE, Dance and Music teaching as part of the Learning Together Trust. Whole school theme weeks and theme days also enhance our provision and often link to national and international themes.
